

## **FAQs**

### **Who can apply?**

Legal U.S. residents, age 18 years or older at the time of entry, if an individual, which are also, as of the date of entry either: general contractors, builders or architects, who are licensed by the applicable state governing body or regulatory authority with the authority to grant such license in their respective states of residency as of the date of entry and continuing through the date of any Grant Award. Entrants can be individuals, or can be for-profit organizations and non-profit organizations, provided they have at least one licensed general contractor, licensed builder or licensed architect on staff.

### **How many Grants will be awarded?**

At least one grant of UltraTouch™ Denim Insulation will be awarded. Additional Grants may be awarded depending on the quality of the Applications and the amount of UltraTouch™ Denim Insulation available.

### **What is a community-based green building?**

A community-based green building is a civic-oriented building being constructed with energy efficient, environmentally-friendly and responsible materials, e.g., a performing arts center, hospital, children's museum, school, library, community center, etc.

### **Can I submit more than one Grant Application?**

Yes. Once you submit an Application, you may begin another one (as long as it is for a different project/building).

### **If I am a Grant Recipient, when will I receive my insulation?**

After being notified that you are a Grant Recipient and complete, sign and return a Copyright License and Affidavit of Eligibility, Ownership and Liability Release, we will be in touch to coordinate delivery.

### **What costs am I responsible for if I am awarded a Grant of insulation?**

You will be responsible for storage, install and additional shipping costs of the insulation that may have been incurred *after* delivery of the originally scheduled date. Otherwise, one-way shipping of the insulation will be included as part of the Grant Award.

**If I requested multiple types of insulation, will I receive it all?**

You may or may not. The quantity, value and insulation type of any given Grant Award will be based on the requested amount and type for a given project in a Grant Application.

**Can my project/building be overseas?**

All buildings must be constructed within one of the fifty United States including Washington D.C. Buildings may not be built in Puerto Rico, U.S. Territories and Possessions, or any overseas military installations.

**May I submit my Application via fax or mail?**

No, you must submit your Application online only.

**Will I be able to save my Application and work on it later?**

Yes, you may save your Application at any time by selecting the *Save Draft Application To Be Completed Later* button.

**Will I be able to edit my Application after submitting it?**

No. Once you submit your Application, it is no longer able to be edited.

**What is the deadline for submitting my Application?**

11:59:59 a.m. ET on September 30, 2011.
